



· It may cause an electric




Please don't install the product with the lightening and thunder.

· It may cause an electric shock or fire.




Please plug the power cable firmly into the inner end


Please hold the plug tightly when unplugging the power cable (a part of the copper wire may be disconnected if the grabbing is only made on the cord when pulling out the cable).

· It may cause an electric shock or fire




When connecting the power cables after cutting the cable, please install the product with power off

- It may cause an electric shock or fire




When installing the product, please fix it firmly while using the wall-mounting unit and SCIEWS.

· It may cause a fire.




Please avoid direct rays of the sun or heating devices at a time of installation.


Power & Installation

Please use the designated connection cable within the maximum calling distance designated for the product



## 🔪 3. Operating

#### Instruction for use

#### Conversation with a individual entrance and lobby

- 1. Visitor's image will be shown on the monitor with emitting chime sound when a visitor press the call button on the door camera at the entrance.
- Press the talk ( ) button by watching visitor, and talk with a visitor (Screen is off after 60 sec automatically from the beginning of conversation)
- When press the talk ( ) button after the end of talking with a visitor, Conversation mode will be turned into Standby mode.
- To release the door lock during conversation, press the door release ( ) button.

(In case of using the camera which is interlocked with Door released function)

#### Conversation with guard station

- 1. Press the talk button and guard call ( 🏟 ) button in sequence. Conversation will begin when a guard station respond. (Conversation is not available while a guard station is in use.)
- Melody announcing the call will be emitted when monitors have a call from the guard station.
- 3. Visitor's image will be shown on the monitor with lower chime when it has a call during in conversation with a guard station. Press the talk ( 🥒 ) button to end the call with a guard station and press the call button again to begin the conversation with a visitor. (There is another way to change conversation mode with monitoring button.)
- 4. Calling sound will be emitted through the speaker on the monitor when you have a call from a guard station during in use. Press the talk button for finishing conversation with the lobby first and press the talk button again to begin conversation. (Guard call buttonis another way to change conversation mode)

Note: Be sure to press the talk button right after finishing the conversation with a visitor or a guard station.

### ▶ Priority talk( )

In order to block the noise coming from the lobby during conversation, you can mute those sound with Priority button for more clear conversation.

#### ▶ Initializing the product

- Initializing the product will be executed by pressing the Priority talk and Door release button at the same time for 3 seconds.
  - « Caution: Monitor and household setting will be also initialized when initializing the product.

#### ▶ LED indication (GREEN LED)

Call or monitoring : LED blinks
 Stand by / On use : LED ON

#### ▶ Monitoring

- In case both lobby and individual cameras are installed
   Click the monitor button once in standby mode to check the images from Individual camera. Click the button twice for Lobby images and three times for returning to stnadby mode. (Note. it is not available during the talk)
- In case only lobby camera is installed.Click monitor button once in standby mode to check the images from lobby and click the button twice to return to stnadby mode

#### **▶ SETUP**

- Press the MENU button in use of conversation or monitoring, then displaying the setting menu below.
- · VIDEO ADJUST : Brightness/Contrast/Color



· INFORMATION: Verifying product name & operating software version



- Press the MENU button for more than 3 seconds in standby mode, then displaying the setting menu below.
- · HOME SET: Input information of household



- · INFORMATION: Verifying product name & operating software version
  - · Use 4 function keys positioned right side of the product

Finishing Menu : MENU Select or Input : SELECT

Move upward / rightward : △ Move downward / leftward : ▽

### ▶ VIDEO ADJUST (Calibrating display setting)

Move to VIDEO ADJUST menu with  $\triangle$ ,  $\nabla$  button and press the SELECT button.



- 1. BRIGHTNESS: Adjustable from 0~20, default: 10
- 2. CONTRAST: Adjustable from 0~20, default: 10
- 3. COLOR: Adjustable from 0~20, default: 10
  - Adjusting Brightness/Contrast/Color
  - 1) Move to the desired menu with △, ▽ button
  - Press the SELECT button to enter the menu. (Adjusting level bar is shown)
  - 3) Adjust the values with △, ▽ button
  - 4) Press the SELECT button to return to menu
- RESET display setting: Initializing Brightness/Contrast/Color value Initialization of display setting is begin after confirmation of this process.
  - \*\* Caution : Adjusting display setting and initializing the system is applied to connected devises separately. (DOOR / LOBBY )
- 5. EXIT: Finish the setting menu with SELECT button.

#### INFORMATION (Verifying product name and software version)

Product name and software version can be seen at INFORMATION menu by moving with  $\triangle/\nabla$  button.



- 1) Model: Product name [CAV-70GA]
- 2) Version: Software version

(Firmware version could be different from the version on the user manual)

- 3) Video: Video format type(PAL / NTSC)
- 4) Video IN : Currently input device(DOOR / LOBBY)
- \* Note: Current status of Video/Video IN subject shall be shown when there is incoming signal from the connected items.

(This is not shown on the INFORMATION in HOME SET menu)

#### ▶ HOME SET (Input information of household)

Move to HOME SET menu with  $\triangle$ ,  $\nabla$  button and press the SELECT button to enter. Move to desired item with  $\triangle$ ,  $\nabla$ 



Building/Household number setting (HOME No. Set)

This menu is to set the HOME No. You can see information of current household in this.

- Caution: Default value is 1234 5678
- 2) Press the SELECT button the change the value.



- 3) Input the value with △/▽ button and SELECT button from the 1 digit.
  - : Default on household number is 8 digit numbers. Blanks are marked with 0.

(ex : Building no : 101 Household no. : 1 ( 0101 – 0001)

- → Wrong number can be modified with < button.</p>
- 4) Household number is changed when finish inputting 8-digit number.
- 2. Changing password for common lobby access
  - Move to Password subject and press the SELECT button to enter the mode.
  - 2) Input desired number with  $\triangle/\nabla$  and SELECT button.

(When register 4-digit number, it will be changed automatically to new number.)

(Default value: 1234)


- Caution: Be sure to use same number for security aspect.
   (0000 and 1234 is not usable for password for security reason)
- LOBBY ID: Select the lobby phone that will do the minitoring when multiple lobby phones are connected.


(LOBBY ID select function is available from version 3.1)

- 1) Click SELECT button to move to LOBBY ID menu by using  $\triangle/\nabla$  button.
- Click SELECT to select the item.(Current setting will be displayed: Default 01)
- 3) Input 01~39 numbers( LOBBY ID that will carry out monitoring) by using △/▽ buttons.
- 4) Click SELECT button to complete the setting.
- 4. EXIT: Press the SELECT button to end the setting menu.










Suitable position for monitor



# 7. Trouble shooting

\* If you think that the product has trouble, please first check below contents before you ask a repair.

The power supply is not on. All works are stopped	1. The power supply cord is missing or not. 2. The power supply switch (down) is off or not.			
A Call operation is not performed.  (Door, Interphone function)	The wiring between other units is connected correctly in good order or not.     The wiring is missing or not.	Please refer to connection related page and manage.     Please connect correctly to the terminal.		
The product does not produce the sound. (Call volume, Talk volume)	A sound volume lies in minimum or not.	Please adjust the sound volume properly turning to the up, as you want.
